
Farrakhan Concerns Jews

"Contortionist mirror on the wall, who's the slickest of 'em all? Jew-baiting Black Muslim leader Louis Farrakhan, who by spewing forth anti-semitism, guarantees himself reams of publicity and such colossal audiences in every city that he is about to become to bigotry what Bruce Springsteen is to rock."

Those were the words not of an angry Jew, but the words of a Black man noted for his outspoken defense of civil rights: syndicated columnist, Carl Rowan. The analogy to Bruce Springsteen seems particularly appropriate here at UCLA where black and Hispanic hypocrites speaking through their respective newspapers have joined the followers of "The Boss" of bigotry. Farrakhan has been held up by the anti-semitic groupies as a champion of the oppressed and as a man who is condemned only because he speaks the "truth" that white people, especially Jews, do not want to hear.

It is easy for Farrakhan's supporters to dismiss white critics as racists, but how do they rebut the widespread criticism from the leaders of their own communities? According to Nommo, Black leaders have simply "bowed down to the pressures of the Jewish community," and La Gente dismisses Hispanic



political critics as "bootlickers." Who is this man who is able to not only generate widespread anger, but also cause his own alleged constituents to turn on each other?

Louis Eugene Wolcott was born in New York in 1933 and grew up in Boston. He was a calypso singer until 1955 when he ws recruited by Malcolm X to the Nation of Islam, a group of Black Moslems led by Elijah Muhammad. In 1965, Elijah Muhammad gave "Calypso gene" the Muslim name of Farrakhan and later that year, when Malcolm X was assassinated, he became the head of the main Harlem mosque. A decade later, Elijah Muhammad died and the Nation of Islam split into two factions: the American

Muslim Mission, headed by Muhammad's son, and the Naton of Islam, led by Farrakhan. According to ADL, the former has approximately 100,000 members while Farrakhan's adherents number between 5,000 and

Farrakhan's notoriety began after a Black reporter for the Washington Post, Milton Coleman, reported that Jesse Jackson had described Jews as "Hymies." Farrakhan accused Coleman in a speech of being a "no good, filthy traitor," and said that "one day soon we will punish you with death" (Los Angeles Times, April 11, 1984). Farrakhan later denied that he threatened Coleman's life but added that in the independent Black state, he advocates "those kinds of traitors will be punished with death" (Chicago Sun-Times, July 31, 1984).

Farrakhan did not only threaten Coleman, he also threatened all Black leaders who dared to disagree with him: "Every leader should be held accountable at the cost of his or her life. Death should be the penalty for traitorous activity' (Charlotte Observer, March 1984). During an August 1984 speech, Farrakhan asked the crowd what should be done with black leaders who seek Jewish support. Someone shouted: "Kill them." Farrakhan replied: "I didn't say it. I just seconded the motion" (Newsday, Aug. 19, 1984).

Farrakhan attracted the most attention, however, for his attacks against Jews. When Jews attack Jesse Jackson, he said, they are attacking all Blacks. "If you harm this brother, I warn you in the name of Allah, this will be the last one you do harm"(February 25, not see how and Black 1984).

Farrakhan quickly made it clear that his feelings toward the Jews ran much deeper than just anger over their alleged mistreatment of Jackson when he told radio listeners on March 11, 1985 that "Hitler was a very great man." This comment was so obviously inane and insensitive that Jackson was compelled to repudiate Farrakhan's remarks.

Farrakhan's views on the relationship between Judaism and Zionism are exoutgrowth of Jewish transgression" (Washington Post, July 27, 1985, my emphasis). In his recent Los Angeles appearance, Farrakhan declared that Jews "are not the chosen people of G-d...the Black people are." As for Farrakhan's criticism of Israel, he is entitled to his opinion; of course, his claim that the Jews stole the Palestinian homeland is historically inaccurate — but veracity has never been very important

Kadafi has provided Farrakhan with a \$5 million interest-free loan to start a marketing organization called POWER (People Organized and Working for Economic Rebirth). No one begrudges the Nation of Islam a loan to help stimulate Black "economic rebirth," but it is ironic that Blacks would see Kadafi as an ally given the historical oppression of Blacks by Arabs. As one writer in the Black periodical Ebony explained: "the Arabs, in league with the Portuguese, were the chief instigators and the main profiteers of the slave trade....Indeed, it was the Arabs who showed the white man what a fortune could be made in Black flesh....I do is that his message of hope
